

Why a report on AI in the notarial profession?

- 1. Exploring the possibilities of AI for the notarial profession.
- 2. Identifying any risks associated with the use of AI in general and with the specific use of AI by notaries.

First, what is AI?

- 1. Automation of routine tasks
- 2. Supporting intelligence
- 3. Extended intelligence
- 4. Autonomous decision making
